

JUNEAU YOUTH FOOTBALL LEAGUE SCHOLARSHIP & DISCOUNT POLICIES—2008

Scholarships

Scholarships are available through the City & Borough of Juneau Parks & Recreation Department. The maximum scholarship available to a youth is \$100 for all activities from July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009. Do not apply before July 1.

Due to limited available CBJ funds, it is important that you apply as soon as possible after July 1 to increase your chance of being awarded a scholarship.

This year, for any CBJ scholarships awarded to lower division participants, JYFL will match up to a maximum of \$25 for Pee Wees and \$50 for Cubs, Juniors and Seniors. JYFL will require scholarship applicants to submit an application for scholarship or a notification of receipt of scholarship from CBJ so an estimated balance due after scholarship and match can be provided to the participant at registration. This amount needs to be paid at registration. When JYFL is notified of the actual scholarship amount, any adjustment will be needed – be it an additional amount due from the participant or a refund to the participant.

JYFL will continue to match scholarships received by Crimson Bear players at 100% (if CBJ pays \$50, JYFL will pay \$50).

Multi-Participant Discounts for Lower Division

For families with more than one youth participating in the program, the following family caps apply to registration fees:

Families with lower division participants only or one Crimson Bear: \$450 cap

No registration is due for the lower division participants in families with two or more Crimson Bear participants. For maximization of CBJ scholarship and JYFL match, a family can elect to “pay the registration” for the lower division participant(s) and take an offsetting credit against the combined registration of the Crimson Bear participants.

Raffle Discounts for Lower Division

For families with more than one youth participating in the program, the following family caps apply to raffle ticket sales:

Families with lower division participants only:	\$400
Families with multiple lower division and one Crimson Bear	\$400
Families with multiple Crimson Bear participants:	No raffle requirement

Raffle Requirement for Each Division:

Seniors/Juniors = \$200, Cubs \$100, PeeWees \$50
