

JYFL 2011 SEASON—GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

REGISTRATION DATES/LOCATION: Saturdays, July 9, 16, 23, 30 from 9 am to 1 pm. Registration is considered late after the two-week, all division camps have completed practices and teams have been chosen. No registrations will be accepted after August 20th.

REGISTRATION/SPORTS PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS/SCHOLARSHIP: *Only completed registrations will be accepted.* A complete registration includes the registration form, sports physical, and fee; if you are new to JYFL, we need to verify the participant's date of birth (JYFL will not keep the certificate).

Applications for scholarship recipients will be accepted after JYFL has received confirmation of the dollar amount CBJ will grant. After JYFL applies its matching scholarship amount (up to \$25 for flag/cubs, up to \$50 for junior/seniors, you will be expected to pay the balance at time of registration.

All participants **MUST** submit a sport physical form filled out by a licensed medical doctor, nurse practitioner, or chiropractor. **EXCEPTION:** Flag football players are not required to have a sport physical.

INCOMPLETE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED—.

GEAR OUT: Players will receive gear upon completed registration. Coaches will inform cheerleaders when they will receive gear.

MANDATORY PARENT MEETINGS: Parents will be notified what time the mandatory parent meetings will be held, most likely during Round Robin. The meetings will be at the football field, and important season information regarding game and travel schedules, parent and participant conduct, and raffle tickets will be addressed at this meeting.

RAFFLE TICKETS: The sale of raffle tickets helps pay for the cost of the league and helps keep the out of pocket registration lower. Failure to sell the required amount of raffle tickets by the designated completion date may lead to the participant being ineligible to participate in the post-season competition.

ROUND ROBIN is scheduled for August 20, and is the kick off for the regular season. The game schedule will be posted at www.juneaufootball.com. Team photographs will be taken.

TRAVEL: There is no regular season travel currently scheduled for 2011. However, some postseason events may be possible. In the case of any selection process for postseason or travel events one criterion for participation will be complete sale of all raffle tickets assigned to the participant. Participants will be expected to adhere to a code of conduct outlined in the JYFL Rules (available online) and which will be addressed during the Mandatory Parent Meeting. Participants who fail to

follow the code of conduct or the JYFL Rules may be expelled from the program for the remainder of the season.

HOUSING VISITING PLAYERS: In our continuing attempt to improve relations with our sister leagues JYFL may be hosting them for games during this year. We will be providing host families for their players during these weekends. JYFL families will be asked to provide this housing.

WHERE TO GET A PHYSICAL: JYFL will be compiling a list medical providers giving discounted physicals. Please watch ww.juneaufootball.com for details when available. You are of course free to use the practitioner of your choice.

WAIVERS up or down are always at the discretion of the Board. Typically, waivers up will be accepted as long as the division coaches, division rep, and parents are all in agreement. Waivers down must be submitted to the Board and approved at a regularly scheduled board meeting, and are only approved in extreme circumstances.

TEAM SELECTIONS are made by league in consultation with the coaches. The guiding principle in player placement is the development of competitive teams through an equitable distribution. Requests to place siblings on the same team in a division or on separate teams in a division will be granted provided the players are registered prior to August 13th. Where one sibling is a cheerleader and the other is a player, the player will first be assigned to a team, then the cheerleader.

INTERESTED IN COACHING? JYFL will be providing an extensive coaching clinic on August 6th. If you are interested in becoming an assistant football or cheer coach this is a perfect opportunity to get started even if you have no experience. See juneaufootball.com for details.
